PMICSL hosted the first SAARC Project Management Conference on Sept. 24-26 at Hotel Galadari, Colombo, in collaboration with Project management Institute (PMI) chapters in the South Asian region.

## Project Management Professional (PMP)®

PMI's Project Management Professional (PMP)® credential is the most important industry-recognized certification for project managers. Globally recognized and demanded, the PMP® demonstrates that you have the experience, education and competency to lead and direct projects.

This recognition is seen through increased marketability to employers and higher salary; according to the PMI Project Management Salary Survey—Seventh Edition, certification positively impacts project manager salaries.

### Who should apply?

The PMP recognizes demonstrated competence in leading and directing project teams. If you're an experienced project manager looking to solidify your skills, stand out to employers and maximize your earning potential, the PMP credential is the right choice for you.

### PMP Requirements

To apply for the PMP, you need to have either:

A four-year degree (bachelor's or the global equivalent) and at least three years of project management experience, with 4,500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.

- OR -

A secondary diploma (high school or the global equivalent) with at least five years of project management experience, with 7,500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.

### Examination

The PMP Examination is a paper based test (PBT), which consists of 200 multiple choice questions of which 25 are pretest/unscored questions, which are placed randomly throughout the exam. Total time allotted is 4 hours.

### How to Apply

To register for the examination you need to obtain the PMI Membership via [www.pmi.org](http://www.pmi.org). PMI membership costs USD \$139 to join (plus USD \$10 application fee) and USD \$129 for annual renewal. PMI member rate for the PMP Exam amounts to USD 405.

## Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM)<sup>®</sup>

PMI's CAPM is a valuable entry-level certification for project practitioners. Designed for those with little or no project experience, the CAPM demonstrates your understanding of the fundamental knowledge, terminology and processes of effective project management.

Whether you're a student, new to project management, changing careers, or already serving as a subject matter expert on project teams, the CAPM can get your career on the right path or take it to the next level.

### Who should apply?

If you're a less experienced project practitioner looking to demonstrate your commitment to project management, improve your ability to manage larger projects and earn additional responsibility, and stand out to potential employers, the CAPM certification is right for you.

### CAPM Requirements

To apply for the CAPM, you need to have:

A secondary diploma (high school or the global equivalent)

- AND -

At least 1,500 hours experience

- OR -

23 hours of project management education by the time you sit for the exam.

If you have gained experience leading and directing projects, you may want to see if you are ready for the Project Management Professional (PMP)<sup>®</sup> credential.

### Examination

The CAPM Examination is a paper based test (PBT), which consists of 150 multiple choice questions of which 15 are pretest/unscored questions, which are placed randomly throughout the exam. Total time allotted is 3 hours.

### How to Apply

To register for the examination you need to obtain the PMI Membership via [www.pmi.org](http://www.pmi.org). PMI membership costs USD \$139 to join (plus USD \$10 application fee) and USD \$129 for annual renewal. PMI member rate for the PMP Exam amounts to USD 225.
